Checking into Barcelona's iconic landmark.

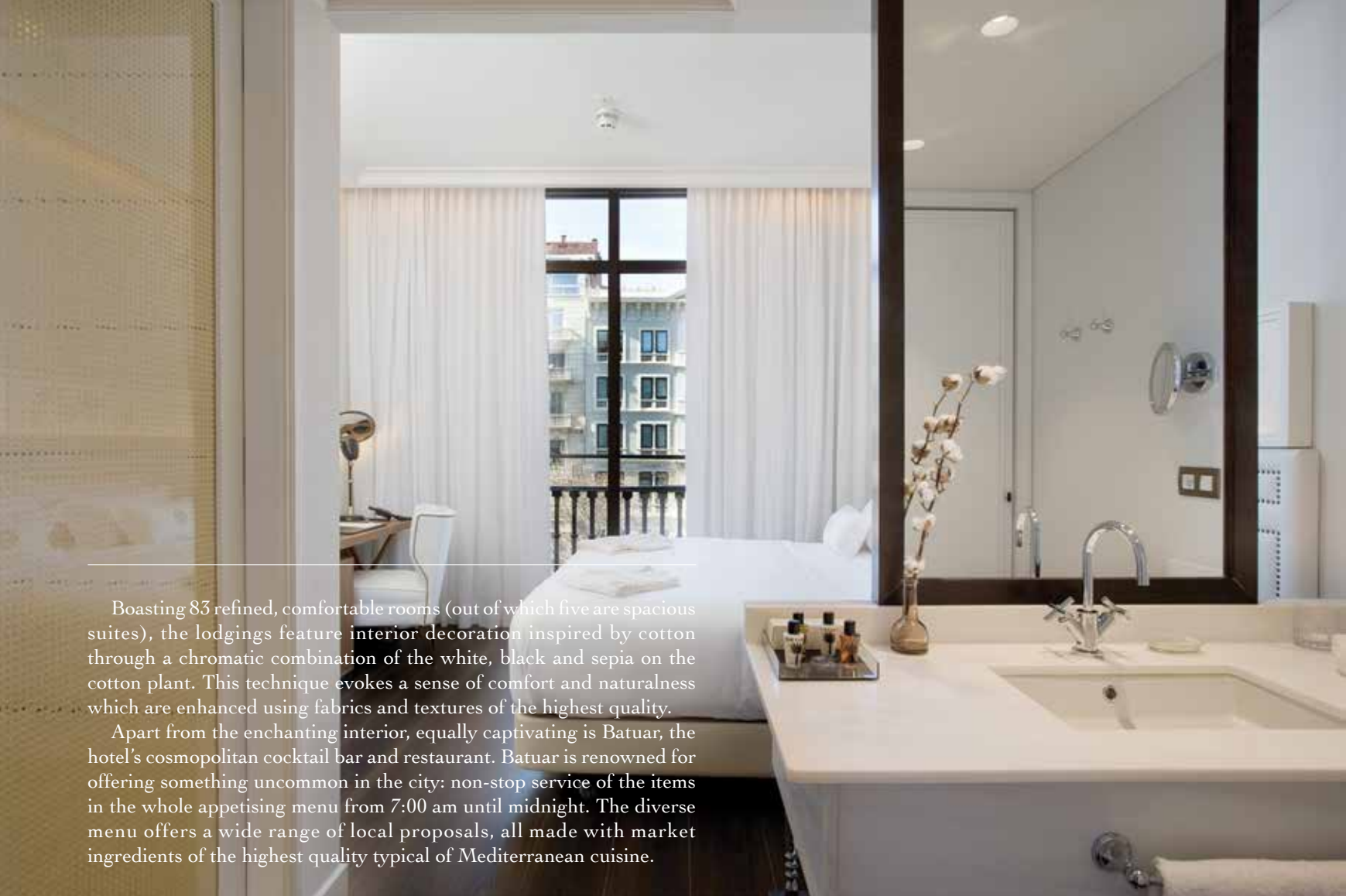




The Cotton House is a spellbinding boutique hotel that stands its ground amongst the hustle and bustle of the Spanish metropolis that is Barcelona. Rising imposingly on the site of the former headquarters of the Cotton Textile Foundation, *Fundación Textil Algodonera*, the emblematic 19th-century building built in neoclassical style is currently a beloved landmark of the Catalonian capital.

Erected on the orders of a family of the Catalan bourgeoisie when the textile industry was at its height, it was sold in the middle of the 20th Century to the Cotton Producers Guild which established its headquarters there with the aim of housing the highest possible number of cotton-producing bodies and services: the idea was to create a genuine Cotton House Hotel. Fast forward to the 21st century, the five-star hotel is now a leading accommodation to discover the true essence of Barcelona.





Boasting 83 refined, comfortable rooms (out of which five are spacious suites), the lodgings feature interior decoration inspired by cotton through a chromatic combination of the white, black and sepia on the cotton plant. This technique evokes a sense of comfort and naturalness which are enhanced using fabrics and textures of the highest quality.

Apart from the enchanting interior, equally captivating is Batuar, the hotel's cosmopolitan cocktail bar and restaurant. Batuar is renowned for offering something uncommon in the city: non-stop service of the items in the whole appetising menu from 7:00 am until midnight. The diverse menu offers a wide range of local proposals, all made with market ingredients of the highest quality typical of Mediterranean cuisine.





The ambience of Batuar is a reflection of the spirit of the hotel: a certain colonial flavour, sophisticated, discreet, elegant, and at the same time, fresh. Enjoying some tapas and a drink in its lush, spacious terrace is a very tempting idea that should not be missed. *A*
